Professional standards

- 1 Promote the rights, strengths and wellbeing of people, families and communities.
- 2 Establish and maintain the trust and confidence of people.
- 3 Be accountable for the quality of my practice and the decisions I make.

- 4 Maintain my continuing professional development.
- 5 Act safely, respectfully and with professional integrity.
- 6 Promote ethical practice and report concerns.

The Local Authority becomes the corporate parent of any child who comes into care.

As corporate parent, the local authority should: -

- act in their best interests, and promote their physical and mental health and wellbeing
- encourage them to express their views, wishes and feelings
- take into account their views, wishes and feelings
- help them gain access to, and make the best use of, services provided by the local authority and its relevant partners
- promote high aspirations, and seek to secure the best outcomes
- ensure they are safe, and have stability in their home lives, relationships and education or work; and
- prepare them for adulthood and independent living
