Analysis

Accuracy – information must be accurate

New – new information can change the picture

Acknowledge – acknowledge missing or conflicting information

Look – examine information and how this may connect with other things we know

YOU – be mindful how your perspective/role impacts on how you interpret information

Scepticism – question information you have

Investment – who has a vested interest in how the information is interpreted

Synthesis – consider information in terms of the whole picture


Gather information
