

Background

- E-safety sub group
 - Over 12 years, massive change in agenda over this time
- CAMHS Transformation fund
 - Funding allocated to Safe and Sound, Dudley's Community Safety Partnership to carry out needs assessment and Cybersurvey in relation to the Internet and emotional health and wellbeing





Following the Needs Assessment and Cybersurvey

- Conference
- Shared reports and recommendations with partners
- Shared survey results with schools and with young people via Young Health Champions
- Identified priority actions and added to the 17 / 18 work plan (including feedback from conference)
- Began work around 'longer term' actions
- Work with Public Health to update online safety questions in Health Related Behaviour Questionnaire
- Change in terminology to Online Safety
